Beyond Borders ECPAT Canada announces its 2014 Media Awards nominees

Awards honour Canadian journalists for exemplary work covering child sexual exploitation

WINNIPEG, MB – Forty journalists from 15 Canadian media outlets have been nominated to receive an award for their coverage of issues related to child sexual abuse and exploitation.

Beyond Borders ECPAT Canada, a child rights advocacy organization, recognizes the crucial role journalists play in raising awareness of this worldwide scourge against children. The Media Awards is an opportunity to celebrate their work. The winners will receive their awards at a ceremony on Monday, November 17, 2014, at the Canadian Museum for Human Rights in Winnipeg, Manitoba.

"Internet has enabled our children and youth to an exposure of pornography that is beyond any previous generations," says Darlene Newton, co-chair of the Media Awards. "This will have an effect on them as adults- how much is still yet to be determined."

Generation XXX, The Pornification of our Children, is a symposium being held at the museum the morning of the awards and will discuss how easily our children are accessing pornography and the dire effects it's having on them. Attendees will learn from leading experts and a former pornography addict about these effects and what they can do about them.
